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**B**everly Hills, California. Guests and celebrated chefs alike are hosted in the main kitchen of this French Chateau styled residence. A second kitchen (not shown) remains the homeowner's private working kitchen. The stunning home features exotic slab marble floors throughout. Carrera marble is also seen on the countertops, backsplashes, and in the floating light fixture that suspends 12-inches down from the ceiling, above the island.

A curved peninsula faces the breakfast

area and includes radiused custom cabinet doors and a concealed warming drawer. Beveled clear glass doors allow light to pass between the spaces. The cabinet doors are entirely hand made and embellished with custom carvings. Illuminated with rope lighting, hand-carved friezes encircle the room at ceiling soffit and above the island. The hood is defined with additional hand carved embellishments. For convenience, two dishwashers flank the main sink, and a working pantry is accessed through the leaded glass door.

**PRODUCTS USED:** Keystone Cabinetry, frameless door style, maple with hand marbled finish to mimic countertops; Sub-Zero all-refrigerator, all-freezer and refrigerator drawers; Gaggenau cooktop, under counter ovens, and warming drawer; Miele dishwashers; Grohe faucets; Carrera marble countertops and backsplash; slab marble floor; rope lighting above frieze/soffits.
