This spectacular 650-square foot kitchen was designed in conjunction with the rest of the cabinetry in this state-of-the-art beach land, 35,000-square foot home in Punta-Mita, Mexico.

To enhance the furniture look cabinetry, with its highly detailed inlays and carvings, the designer used a French Walnut color with a Cappuccino glazes. The Crena Classico 4-inch bullnose marble countertops complement the cabinetry; the same marble was used for the flooring. Although the overall design might be considered Old World, the use of a professional style range brings this kitchen into the future. A special second prep sink was included in the island to accommodate more than one cook.
